

ICT

Pupils are taught ICT for 1 hour a week. Each child has access to their own laptop during each session.

Topics covered:

Year 1 – modelling, word banks, information around us, labelling and classifying, representing information and understanding instructions.

Year 2 – writing stories, creating pictures, finding information, routes, questions and answers.

Year 3 – combining text with graphics, manipulating sound, databases, exploring simulations and email.

Year 4 – writing for different audiences, developing and using images, branching databases, collecting and presenting information and modelling effects on screen.

Year 5 – graphic modelling, analysing data, evaluating information, spreadsheets, controlling devices and monitoring conditions and changes.

Year 6 – multimedia presentation, spreadsheet modelling, control and monitoring and using the internet to search databases and interpret information.

The use of ICT is both stimulating and motivating whilst at the same time it enhances and extends the children's learning. The children are encouraged and supported in lessons in the hope that they can exploit the full potential of ICT throughout their lives.
