1st XI – Report (35 Over match)

Unfortunately he was dismissed caught behind with only 7 runs required. Earlier St Benedicts managed a strong total of 161 for 8. This is the third loss in the row for the 1st XI which is disappointing but the margin of defeat was very tight and perhaps with a little more luck we will start winning these close matches!

The other sides had considerably more success with all three teams winning at home (2nds, U14As and U14Bs). The U14 B team match was dominated by **Jacob Haftel** who took 3 for 5 off four overs when bowling and followed that performance up with a magnificent 66* to guide his team to a seven wicket win. The U15A team also won convincingly with **Kane Thomas** scoring 95 (the highest score by an Aldenham player this season) and **Francis Amos** a powerful 41.
