## Report

The second string Year 9 and 10 boys played their first league match today which was also the first competitive outing for boys' tennis of the season. Aldenham were at home against The John Warner School on a dry but cold and uninviting Tuesday afternoon.

With the final seeding positions still up for grabs until the start of the fixture, five boys were ultimately chosen with Toby Olins playing in just the singles and Justin Wah acting as a doubles specialist.

The first match to finish was the doubles pair of Wah and George Leach who comfortably saw off John Warner's third and fourth seed players. Fergus Browne then completed his set after a slow start and this gave Aldenham a two set lead.

Toby Olins started and finished his fourth seed singles rubber in quick and efficient fashion playing his first tennis match for over a year. Although rusty on his serve he was more than enough for the Warner's lowest player and this extended the Aldenham lead further still. With Leach winning his third rubber the overall match was to go to Aldenham no matter what befell the final two rubbers.

This was just as well because Louis Alterman made a meal of his singles set allowing his weaker opponent to gain confidence. He eventually lost 7-3 in the subsequent tie break following the six all score line. He also lost his doubles match with Browne but this was a dead rubber as Aldenham already had the magic 8 points.
