

Aldenham School Anti-Bullying Code

Bullying, physical, verbal or by exclusion is completely unacceptable at Aldenham. Here is the School Anti-Bullying Code:-

1. The School Rules on Bullying are very clear. This Code is a summary of these and the procedures which the School applies. They are for the information of pupils, Staff & parents.
2. Any verbal or physical action which is designed to hurt, intimidate or make a pupil do something against their will is considered to be bullying.
3. Pupils who see bullying, or are the object of it, or who suspect it may be going on must immediately inform a member of Staff or a senior student. Concealing bullying or allowing it to continue is not acceptable.
4. Pupils who bully others will be removed from lessons, activities, free time, and the normal School routine. They are liable to detention both in free time and after School or to temporary or permanent exclusion from school. Parents will be informed.
5. Pupils who criticise or mistreat the victims of bullying or those who have reported it place themselves in contravention of the School Rules on bullying.
